CODE OF CONDUCT

Players, Parents and Coaches are reminded that the highest levels of sportsmanship are expected on the day.

Any dissent towards officials, players or JIS staff members will result in you being removed from the school grounds.

FOOTBALL FUNDAY TOURNAMENT RULES AND REGULATIONS

All matches will be played according to the FIFA/UEFA Laws of the Game with the following amendments:

- Number of Players 10 players max. in a squad and all matches are 5-a-side.
- Rolling substitutes apply and can be made at any time from the half way line.
- Games will be one period of 10 minutes.
- Games will be centrally timed.
- There will be a 3 minute gap between games to allow for players to exit/enter the field of play.

Start of Play

- It is your responsibility to be on the pitch ready to play at the appropriate times.
- If a team is not on the pitch when the whistle goes, the opposing team will be awarded a 3-0 victory.
- The team named first on the order of play will kick off from the centre of the pitch.
- Teams cannot score directly from a kick off.
- The ball can be passed forwards or backwards from kick off
- There is no offside.
- Penalties will be taken from the edge of the goal
- There is no 'back pass' rule (goalkeepers can pick up the ball if it is passed to them by one of their own players).
- All free kicks and corners are direct. The opposition must be 5 metres away.
- Goal kicks will be throw-outs by the goal keeper.
- Goalkeepers will NOT be allowed to kick the ball from hand.
- Throw ins- the ball must be thrown from behind the head with both feet on the ground. U9 & U8 throw ins will be at the discretion of the referee.

Pool Stage

All pool matches will be 4 points for a win, 2 points for a draw, 1 point for a loss.

If teams are tied on points at the end of the pool stage, the result of the head-to-head game (where applicable) will be used to determine who goes through to the knockout stage. If teams are still

equal then the following factors will determine who goes through to the knockout stage:

- goal difference.
- goals scored.
- sudden death penalties.

Knockout Stage (age group dependent)

If scores are level at full time in quarter-finals, semi-finals and finals, games will be decided by:

- Golden goal in 3 minutes, if no goal then;
- penalty shoot-out 3 penalties per team; if scores still tied then;
- sudden death penalty shoot-out 1 per team until a result is achieved.
- all players in the squad must take a penalty before anyone can take a second penalty.


Equipment

- Shin pads are compulsory for all players.
 Players will not, under any circumstances, be
 allowed to participate without shin pads. It is
 the responsibility of players and coaches to
 ensure that players entering the field of play are
 wearing shin pads. Players that break this rule
 will be asked to leave the field of play.
- Appropriate footwear must be worn by players at all times.
- Jewellery must not be worn on the field of play. This includes watches, rings, necklaces/ chains, earrings, and piercings of any kind. It is your responsibility to ensure that jewellery is removed.
- Teams must wear shirts of the same colour.
 The goalkeeper should be wearing a different colour to their team-mates. In the event of a clash of colours, bibs will be provided.


Water

Each player needs to bring a bottle of water – JIS will provide facilities to refill during the tournament.






ALLS MAP
