Year 10- 13 Minimum specifications are listed below:

- Macintosh (OS 14 or higher), Windows 11 laptop, Chromebook, Linux OS
- Platform must have a physical keyboard suitable for touch-typing
- Memory (RAM) 4GB
- Processor Type - Multi-core
- Audio / Video - Students will need headphones or earphones as well as a built in microphone
- Web Camera
- Wireless card: 802.11 AC (Wi-Fi 5) or higher
- Platform must have the latest version of Chrome and Firefox Browsers installed
- Have antivirus software installed
- The battery should be able to last all day

Every student is issued with a secure locker to store their device during break and lunchtimes.
